



# Nick Elliott

Nicholas Elliot Woods (born November 16, 1997) is a 6'9" electronic dance music DJ, producer and song writer who is known professionally as Nick Elliott. Nick was born in St. Louis, Missouri but moved to Virginia at an early age. Even after the move, he was still enthralled with the rich musical culture of St. Louis which led to an interest and performance with brass and percussion instruments. In 2011, Elliott was introduced to EDM and was instantly hooked. He remembers the first song he fell in love with was "First of the Year (Equinox)" by Skrillex.

While performing locally and working on the production aspect of music in his free time, qualified for the team USA elite Junior Triathlon Team. At only 16 years old, Elliott became a professional triathlete. This led Nick to train for close to forty hours a week, and travel both across the country and the world to represent Team USA in the endurance sports championships. Unfortunately, his career would be cut short. At only nineteen years old, Elliott suffered a career ending injury after a cycling accident. Unable to race again after coming so close to qualifying for the U.S. Olympic Team, he was left depressed and once again, searching for a purpose. He shifted his attention back to music.

Focusing his production skills on EDM with some pop and hip-hop crossover, Elliott draws heavy influences from some of the greats in the industry like, Skrillex, Afrojack, Calvin Harris, David Guetta, and Avicii. He believes that he can inspire people with his mix of different styles and incredibly infectious stage presence. "Producing electronic dance music, playing festivals and clubs, and connecting with music fans are things I've always wanted to do."

Since releasing his first song "Higher Ground," in November 2018 Nick started performing in the DC. and Aspen, CO club scene. In 2019, Elliott has opened for many of the greats at SoundCheck, a venue owned and operated by Club Glow, the list of performers includes: Sander Van Dorn, Dirty South, ilan bluestone, and Matt Zo. Nick has also performed at Bootsy Bellows, a club in Aspen three times; once when the club opened in January 2019, again for X-Games 2019, and for Ajax mountain's closing weekend. Nick also performed at Moonrise Festival 2019 on the Celestial Garden stage. Nick is signed with Lowly Palace for his new song, "All I Want."
